

# FREE Civil Legal Services Providers in Delaware\*

\* Applicants must meet program eligibility requirements. In some instances clients may be required to pay court costs.

## **Delaware Volunteer Legal Services..... (302) 478-8850 (NCC) (888) 225-0582 (K&S Counties)**

Operates the Legal Help Link, which is a service that connects callers to the appropriate legal services organization or a private attorney (private attorneys may charge for their services; payment arrangements must be discussed with individual attorneys).

Types of cases where free representation may be available:

- ◆ Protection from Abuse
- ◆ Custody, visitation and divorce (limited)
- ◆ Guardianships
- ◆ Wills
- ◆ Housing—problems with private landlords
- ◆ Estate planning (wills, powers of attorneys, living wills, & guardianships)
- ◆ Veterans' Issues / Government Benefits

**Housing problems** (ex.: evictions, discrimination, Section 8 / public housing terminations) **(302) 674-8500 (KC)

**Government benefits** (ex.: SSI, Social Security, Medicaid, Medicare, Food Assistance, Welfare, General Assistance, etc.)

**Immigration** (cases for victims of domestic violence, crime, or trafficking, and children in long term foster care or who are abused/ neglected/ abandoned only)

**Elder Law** (ex.: Powers of Attorney, Advanced Health Care Directives, Debt Collection, consumer law problems, and other assistance for those over 60)

**Disability related problems** (ex.: accommodations, discrimination, special education, obtaining assistive technology, receiving vocational training, assistance with mental health & development disabilities facilities/agencies, Medicaid denied coverage, voting rights, etc.)

**Domestic Violence** (Protection from Abuse orders; child custody & visitation; divorce. K&S Counties only)
