- ❖ *That Research estimates that **9 out of 10** people with developmental disabilities will be physically or sexually abused sometime during their life.*
- ❖ *That 88% of cases of sexual abuse are never reported to the authorities and*
- ❖ *That by educating people with disabilities to recognize, report and respond to abuse we take an important step in reducing the violence and crimes committed against them.*

As long as disclosure continues to be a problem for victims, then fear, suffering and psychological distress will remain with the victim (Bagley, 1992)
